RECONNECTION CHARGES

If service has been disconnected a meter reconnection charge must be paid.

After Business Hours	\$ 75.00 (however, it is the policy of the utility not to reconnect after hours)

Bills for service are rendered monthly and become due and payable on the 28th of the month following the period for which service is rendered. A late payment charge of 1 percent per month will be added to bills not paid within 20 days of issuance. This late payment charge will be applied to the total unpaid balance for utility service, including unpaid late payment charges. The late payment charge is applied to all customers. Utility customers may be given a written notice that the bill is overdue no sooner than 20 days after the bill is issued. Unless payment or satisfactory arrangements for payment are made within the next ten days, service may be disconnected.

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE (PCAC)

All energy sales are subject to a positive or negative power cost adjustment charge equivalent to the amount of which the current cost of power (per kWh of sales) is greater or lesser than the base cost of power purchased and produced (per kWh). The base cost of power is currently \$0.079 per kWh.

COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY

As required by state law, the Commitment to Community fee is collected to fund low-income programs and energy conservation programs.

WATER AVERAGING

The Utility bills residential sewer customers using a method that is intended to provide credit for water that is not returned as wastewater (for example, water used for watering lawns) during certain months. This method uses the average water consumed from the months of October to April as the basis for the sewer gallons to be billed for the months of May to September. This averaging method is only applicable to residential customers. Non-residential customers are billed sewer throughout the year equal to the water usage as measure in the monthly meter reading.
